JOB TITLE: Mental Health Clinician

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Working as part of an interdisciplinary team Mental Health Therapist is responsible for Mental health services focused on individuals, families and groups participating in a program. The Mental Health Clinician shares the responsibility for the implementation of comprehensive mental health services with the Director of Mental Health Services and other therapists.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Evaluate client needs through a psycho-social assessment and develop an Individualized Treatment Plan.
- 2. Provide psychotherapy, crisis intervention, referrals to appropriate resources and follow-up visits.
- 3. Maintain complete, accurate, and timely client case records including updated progress notes, releases and consents.
- 4. Acts as a liaison and advocate for clients.
- 5. Maintain a clinical caseload.
- 6. Assist with the internship program and the mental health referral process.
- 7. If licensed, provide weekly individual clinical supervision to mental health interns.
- 8. Participate in weekly individual supervision and clinical case conferences.
- 9. Develop, coordinate and lead support groups.
- 10. Provide training regarding HIV substance abuse and mental health issues to Bienestar staff and related community agencies, as appropriate.
- 11. Make recommendations for referrals for psychiatric medication and neuro-psychological consults.
- 12. Develop and implement quality control methods.
- 13. Maintain statistical data and provide monthly reports.
- 14. Other duties as assigned

EXPERIENCE AND SKILLS:

- 1. Masters Degree required or enrollment in a Masters program in Social Work or Psychology. License preferred.
- 2. Bilingual English/Spanish with excellent written, verbal, public speaking, and organizational skills.
- 3. Demonstrates leadership, management, supervision, organizational planning, and advocacy skills.
- 4. Knowledge of HIV/AIDS epidemic and prevention and knowledge of AIDS services.
- 5. Knowledge of substance use in the Latino community.
- 6. Sensitive to diverse cultures and populations within the Agency service area.
- 7. Able to meet agency transportation and work hours job requirements.
- 8. Mental health experience in a non-profit or human services agency, hospital or volunteer-based organization, preferably with HIV+ population and substance use clinical issues.
- 9. Experience of working with an interdisciplinary team; Ability to be self-motivated and a problem-solving skills.
