JOB TITLE: MENTAL HEALTH CLINICIAN

POSITION DESCRIPTION:

Working as part of an interdisciplinary team, Mental Health Clinician is responsible for mental health services. Services focused on individuals, families and groups participating. The Mental Health Clinician will report directly to the Director of Behavioral Health. The Mental Health Clinician shares the responsibility for the implementation of comprehensive mental health services and assessments.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Evaluate client needs through a psycho-social assessment and develop an Individualized Treatment Plan.
2. Provide psychotherapy, crisis intervention, referrals to appropriate resources and follow-up visits including home sites.
3. Maintain complete, accurate, and timely client case records including updated progress notes, releases and consents.
4. Acts as a liaison and advocate for clients.
5. Maintain a clinical caseload
6. Participate in weekly individual supervision and clinical case conferences
7. Provide training regarding Substance Abuse and Mental Health to BIENESTAR staff and related community agencies, as appropriate
8. Make recommendations for referrals for psychiatric medication and neuro-psychological consults
9. Develop and implement quality control methods
10. Maintain statistical data and provide monthly reports
11. Other duties as assigned

EXPERIENCE AND SKILLS:

1. Master's degree required or enrollment in a Masters program in Social Work or Psychology. Licensed preferred.
2. Bilingual English/Spanish with excellent written, verbal, public speaking, and organizational skills.
3. Demonstrates leadership, management, supervision, organizational planning, and advocacy skills.
4. Knowledge of HIV/AIDS epidemic and prevention and knowledge of AIDS services
5. Knowledge of substance use in the LGBT community
6. Sensitive to diverse cultures and populations within the Agency service area.
7. Able to meet agency transportation and work hours job requirements.
8. Experience of working with an interdisciplinary team
9. Requires Annual Tuberculosis screening.
10. Must have licensure from California Board of Behavioral Sciences
11. Ability to be self-motivated and a problem-solving skills.
